OUR MISSION

House of Refuge is a faith based, nonprofit organization helping homeless families by providing transitional housing and support services that assist residents towards self-sufficiency and permanent housing



Our Programs

When we welcome an eligible family to House of Refuge, we provide a dignified home, furnishings, clothing, food boxes, individualized case management services and employment and education support for up to one year. Residents have access to all services and facilities in our community including the Community Center, the Employment & Education Center and the Donation Center.

We believe through our innovative programming that values employment and education, our families can stabilize their lives and transition from homelessness to self-sufficiency.



Case Management

Every resident at House of Refuge is assigned an experienced case manager who develops an individualized case plan unique to each family. The case plan addresses barriers and outlines steps necessary to reach full employment and/or educational goals. Case management plans may focus on life skills, employment, health & wellness and navigating available benefit programs.

Employment and Education Center

Our on-site, multi-purpose Employee & Education Center (EEC) is staffed by volunteers and an Employment and Education Specialist to help residents gain employment, increase wages and further their education. Residents can visit the EEC to research job opportunities, complete online classes and discuss employment and education goals. All residents are required to participate in the E.A.R.N (Earn A Reliable Net Income) Program which focuses on financial literacy, job/life skills, employment and education. The E.A.R.N program was designed to make each resident more successful once they leave House of Refuge.

Community Center

The Community Center offers school-aged children on-site access to a safe and stable

environment with programming designed to enhance social and educational growth. During the academic year, children can visit the Community Center after school for a nutritional snack and participate in social activities, tutoring, art/pet therapy, STREAM (Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Art & Mathematics) projects and mentoring. During the summer, children can participate in the Summer Program with access to structured activities, lunch and plenty of play time. The Community Center also hosts special events and evening programs for families throughout the year.

Donation Center

Many of our residents arrive with little to no belongings. Through grants and the generosity of our donors, our Donation Center provides clothing, furniture, food and other household items at no cost to our residents. Upon move-in, families are welcomed to the House of Refuge community with a welcome basket, new kitchen items, beds, a pantry starter kit and can shop for furniture, clothing and other household items. Throughout the month, residents have access to the Donation Center to supplement their family's food, clothing and essential household needs. Every item a family acquires from the Donation Center is theirs to keep and take with them when they leave House of Refuge.
